

Reading champs will take home their trophy for the weekend but must return it to school on Monday.

Next week, teachers will be sending home the Curriculum Overviews for the Summer Term 2024 for each class.

These documents will share what your child will be learning about in each subject from now up until the summer holidays in July. Staff have provided some 'recommended reads' for their classes which are linked to their curriculum topics.

Homework and reading expectations have been outlined for the term and as part of our home/school agreement, we expect that families support their child/ren at home in order to enhance and consolidate their learning in school. All homework is handed out on a Wednesday and must be returned on a Monday.

Reminder that Y6 SATs will take place from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May. Pupils will sit assessments each morning based on grammar, spelling, reading and Maths (arithmetic and problem solving and reasoning).

All pupils must be in school that week in order to sit the assessments.

Y6 SATs booster classes resumed this week. They will continue to run from 8.15am on Mondays to Thursdays with Mrs Georgiou and will finish on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May. There will be no booster classes during SATs Week itself.
