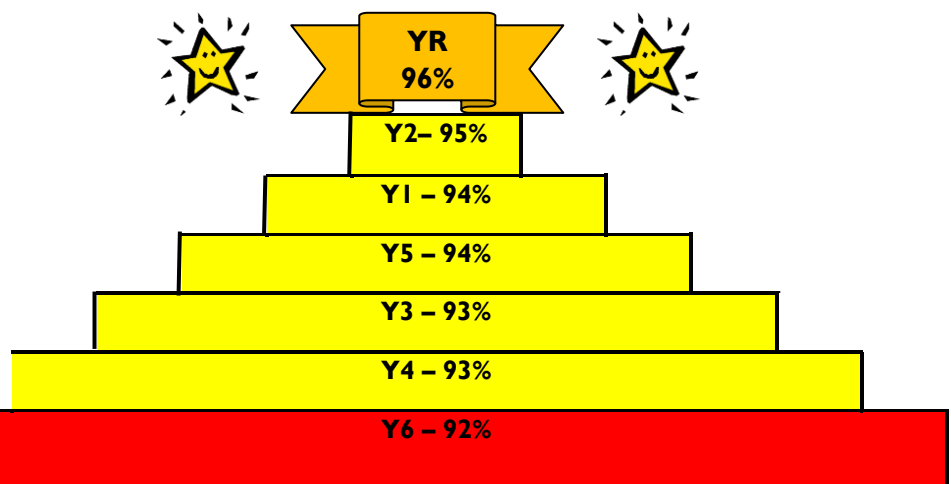

Staff have provided some 'recommended reads' for their classes which are linked to their curriculum topics.</p> <p>Homework and reading expectations have been outlined for the term and as part of our home/school agreement, we expect that families support their child/ren at home in order to enhance and consolidate their learning in school. All homework is handed out on a Wednesday and must be returned on a Monday.</p>	<p>Reminder that Y6 SATs will take place from Monday 13th to Thursday 16th May.
