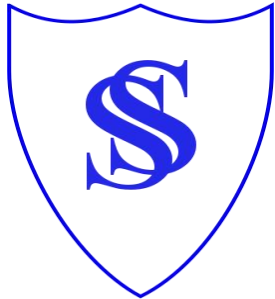


Year 2 Curriculum Overview – Summer 2024
